Directions & Map to Kamakakuokalani

1. Head towards the University of Hawaii – Manoa campus on the H 1.
2. Take the University Avenue cut off.
3. Turn Right onto Dole Street.
4. The road will turn slightly right and you will see a big parking complex on the right side of the road. Turn into the parking complex and you will see Kamakakuokalani Center for Hawaiian Studies to the right of the parking area. If you pass Kanewai Community Park, located on the right side of the street than you have gone too far.
5. There should be free parking on Dole Street since it's a Saturday and the University is on summer break or parking is available for \$3 in the structure.
6. Proceed into the Center and there will be signs posted directing you to Halau Haumea, which is located on the bottom floor in front of the garden.
